What to bring

Comfortable clothing and shoes, calculator, and any information or plans you've developed so far for your bookstore (blueprints and photos, financial projections, demographic data, etc.) that you may wish to discuss with the training team.

Directions

The Story & Song Bookstore Bistro is located at 1430 Park Avenue at the entrance to Amelia Park, a traditional neighborhood development on Amelia Island. Historic downtown Fernandina Beach is a few miles away, accessible by taxi, bike, (or a 45 minute walk).

From I-95, take Exit 373 (the A1A) toward Fernandina Beach for about ten miles. Once across the bridge, turn right at the second traffic light (Sadler Rd.), then turn left at the first traffic light (14th St.). After about ½ mile, turn right on Park Avenue, then right again into the parking lot behind the building.

A great vacation destination!

Nearest major airports

Jacksonville (JAX), 30 minutes
(Daytona Beach, 1½ hours; Orlando, 3½ hours; Atlanta, 6 hours)

Ground transportation

Almost all major auto rental companies can be found at the Jacksonville International Airport. Should you prefer not to rent a car — you won't really need one unless you're spending extra time to explore the area — we have made arrangements with 1st Class Transit to meet all your transportation needs, including shuttle service to and from Jacksonville International Airport. Regular taxi service from the airport is also available (about \$65-\$75 one way).
